■ What kind of box do I need?



32 ECT

For lightweight shipments.

MULTI-DEPTH

Cut down size to meet requirements.



275 LB. DOUBLE WALL

Added protection for parts and hardware.

LONG

Long flaps make for easy loading.



TALL

Short flaps for easy closure.

How to measure a box

1.

Listed dimensions are always inside dimensions.

2.

The first dimension is length. Length is always the longest side of the box that has a flap.


3.

The next dimension is width. The width side also has a flap but is always the side shorter than the length.


4.

Height is the only dimension without a flap. Height measurements do not include flaps.


Note: Acceptable manufacturing tolerance is +/- 1/8"

Helpful Hints

To ship via FedEx or UPS, surround each item with 2" of packing material and place each item 2" away from the walls of the box.

To ship via USPS, surround each item with packing materials until items are no longer moving around in the box.

Cubic Volume Calculations

Cubic Inches: $L" \times W" \times H"$

Cubic Feet (from inches): $(L" \times W" \times H") / 1,728$
